Gentlemen:

Subject: Heavy Duty Terg-O-CIDE Formula No. 133

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Revise the statement "No. 133 TERG-O-CIDE is acceptable for use as a Sanitizer and Sanitizing Cleaner in official meat and poultry processing establishments by USDA . . ." to read "No. 133 TERG-O-CIDE is acceptable for use as a non-food contact surface sanitizer and sanitizing cleaner in official meat and poultry processing establishments by USDA"
 - b. Revise "Apply solution twice" to read "A precleaning step is required. Prepare a fresh solution after each use."
 - c. Include a ten (10) minute contact time for the disinfection section.
2. The confirmatory data submitted 7/9/90 are acceptable. This data has been assigned NRID No. 415693-01.
3. The revised Confidential Statement of Formula agrees with the label and is acceptable.
4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.



MULTI-ACTION

A CONCENTRATED DUAL DETERGENT WITH A DUAL PURPOSE

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

TERG-O-CIDE is a concentrated product, and should be diluted before using. Do not mix into other detergents or sanitizers as it may not be compatible.

It must be diluted with either HOT or COLD water before using.

For cleaning and disinfecting floors, walls, curbs, hospitals, restaurants, public rooms, homes, industrial areas, conveyances, etc.

Apply by mop or cloth Heavy Duty TERG-O-CIDE at least two ounces to one gallon of water. In instances, i.e. operating rooms where surfaces are heavily contaminated with organic matter, apply solution twice. For maximum germicidal activity, surfaces to be treated should be wet thoroughly.

FOR CLEANING AND SANITIZING: Apply Heavy Duty TERG-O-CIDE by mop or cloth one (1) ounce to one (1) gallon water. Allow at least two (2) minutes of contact to disinfect. Where heavy amount of infectious disease germs are known to be present, use one (1) ounce of concentrated TERG-O-CIDE per gallon of water.

No 133 TERG-O-CIDE is acceptable for use as a sanitizer and sanitizing clean and poultry processing establishments by the USDA. Before use of this compound, all food and food materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected. After use of 133, the area must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water.

FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING: Apply TERG-O-CIDE by mop or cloth one (1) gallon of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store this product only in its original container and place in a location out of the reach of children. Keep containers closed when not in use. Store above 32°F.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide residue from the use of this product may be disposed of outside or at an approved facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

55 and 30 gallon drums: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by local authorities.

20 gallon and 7 gallon (5 gallon) drums and pails: Triple rinse (or equivalent) for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay at least 100 feet from any other structures. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap outside.
