The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Delete the statement "After use of this compound, all surfaces in the area must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water."
 - Please note that potable water rinses are no longer permitted on food contact surfaces.
 - b. Delete the word "milk."
 - c. Under "Note To Physician," delete the second sentence beginning with "Measures against"
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

MULTI-ACTION

A CONCENTRATED DUAL DETERGENT WITH A DUAL PURPOSE
IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER
INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

TERG-O-CIDE is a concentrated product, and should be diluted before using. It should not be mixed into other detergent or sanitizers as it may not be compatible. It must be diluted with either HOT or COLD water before using.

For cleaning and disinfecting floors, walls, surfaces as found in hospitals, institutions, rooms, homes, industrial areas, conveyances, etc.

Apply by mop or cloth Heavy Duty TERG-O-CIDE at least two ounces to one gallon of water. In instances, i.e. operating rooms where surfaces are heavily contaminated with soil or organic matter, a pre-cleaning step is required. Prepare a fresh solution after each use. For maximum germicidal and detergent activity, surfaces to be treated should be wet thoroughly and allowed to remain wet 10 minutes before rinsing.

FOR CLEANING AND SANITIZING: Apply Heavy Duty TERG-O-CIDE by mop or cloth one (1) ounce to one (1) gallon water. Allow at least two (2) minutes of contact with surface before rinsing. Where heavy amount of infectious disease germs are known to be present, use four (4) ounces of concentrated TERG-O-CIDE per gallon of water.

No. 133 TERG-O-CIDE is acceptable for use as a sanitizer and sanitizing cleaning in meat and poultry processing establishments by the USDA. It can be used to clean countertops and food processing equipment in these establishments. Before use, compound, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or compartment. Heavy soil must be removed with a separate pre-cleaning step. Sanitize with product diluted 2 ounces per gallon of water. After use of this compound, all surfaces must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water.

FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING: Apply TERG-O-CIDE by mop or cloth one (1) ounce to one (1) gallon of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store this product only in its original container and place in a locked storage area out of the reach of children. Keep containers closed when not in use. Store at temperatures above 32°F.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of outside or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: 55 and 35 gallon drums: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

20 gallon and 7 gallon (5 gallon) drums and pails: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay downwind.

1 gallon and 1 pint containers: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash.
