DIRECTIONS FOR USE (as a Deodorizer-Detergent-Sanitizer)

TO DISINFECT, DEODORIZE AND TO REMOVE LIGHT SOIL IN ONE OPERATION FROM TERRAZO, MARBLE OR CERAMIC TILE FLOORS: This one-operation-procedure is suggested ONLY if a light deposit of soil is to be removed. (For the removal of heavy and medium-heavy soil pre-cleaning, as outlined above, is necessary.) Use 3-5 ounces of Deo-Phene per 1 gallon of water and freely apply this mixture with a mop. Leave the diluted disinfectant in contact with the treated areas from 5-10 minutes.

CAUTION:

Avoid contact with eyes. If contact with eyes occurs, rinse abundantly with water. If irritation persists consult a physician. Poisonous if taken internally. In case of swallowing, give the following antidotes: Milk, raw eggs, mucilage, and follow with an emetic (tablespoonful of mustard in a glass of warm water.) Call a physician. Keep away from domestic animals and foodstuffs. Avoid prolonged inhalation of fumes of undiluted material. Avoid skin contact.

NET CONTENTS:

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store this product only in its original container and place in a locked storage area out of the reach of children. Do not store at temperatures below 32°F. Do not store, use, spill or pour near heat, sparks or open flame. Keep containers closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

55, 20 and 7 gallon containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

1 qt. container: Do not reuse empty containers. Wrap container and put in trash.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (as a Disinfectant)

Deo-Phene must always be diluted with water prior to application because the undiluted product may cause skin irritation. Before using Deo-Phene, clean thoroughly all the surfaces to be disinfected. Leave the diluted disinfectant in contact with the treated areas from 5 to 10 minutes. Always add Deo-Phene to the water, and agitate whereby a milky emulsion is formed.

TO DISINFECT and DEODORIZE FLOORS, BATHROOMS, LAVATORIES, SINKS, URINALS, CELLARS, BASEMENTS, etc.: First clean thoroughly. Mix 2 ounces of Deo-Phene with one gallon of water, and apply this mixture with a mop. It is also recommended to add a few ounces of Deo-Phene per one gallon to the scrub water which will deodorize while the floor is cleaned and will leave a pleasant odor.

TO DISINFECT and DEODORIZE GARBAGE CANS, REFRIGERATORS, DRAIN-BOARDS, KITCHEN TABLES, COOLING ROOMS: First clean thoroughly, and then rinse with a dilution of Deo-Phene which has been prepared by adding 2 ounces of Deo-Phene to one gallon of water.

FOR GENERAL DISINFECTING PURPOSES: Dilute Deo-Phene with water at the ratio of one part disinfectant to 90-100 parts of water.

AS AN AID IN PREVENTING THE SPREAD OF ATHLETE'S FOOT FUNGUS: Use a dilution of approximately 3-5 oz. to the gallon of water. Scrub shower stall floors, rubber and plastic bath mats, locker room runways, benches and all surfaces which come in contact with bare feet each day.

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
