DIRECTIONS:

To control German, Brown Banded, Oriental and American roaches; ants and silverfish. Apply the powder lightly, but thoroughly, at the rate of two ounces per 100 square feet of surface. Application should be made to cracks, crevices around water pipes or other openings where insects move or hide, particularly sink and cabinet areas, service areas, bathrooms, places where insects enter premises, such as door sills or other opening. Repeat treatment as needed.

FOR ROACH CONTROL IN SEWERS:

Remove manhole cover and replace with a disc of plywood bored to receive the flexible hose from the truck mounted ventilating equipment. Pour approximately 5 ounces (.3 of 1 lb.) of State 797-A into ventilator-blower attached to manhole of infested sewer line. Clouds of 797-A will then spread over hundreds of feet of roach infested sewer lines. When treating sewers one manhole per 200 feet of line should be treated. Continue application through the next two manholes beyond visible evidence of roach infestation. This treatment is highly effective for the control of American and Oriental roach infestations.

BEDBUG CONTROL:

Dust 797-A into all joints, channels and hollows of bed. Also mattress and adjoining furniture as well as all cracks and crevices in the room should be treated.

FLEA CONTROL ON DOGS AND CATS:

Liberal apply and rub 797-A on skin of the animal. Dust kennel surfaces with 2 oz. per 100 square feet.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Do not reuse empty container. Wash thoroughly with water and detergent. Crush, if possible, and discard in a safe place.
