**CAUTION**

HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. AVOID BREATHING OF SPRAY MIST OR VAPORS. AVOID CONTACT WITH SKIN. WASH THOROUGHLY AFTER USING. AVOID CONTAMINATION OF FEED AND FOODSTUFFS. DO NOT CONTAMINATE MILK, MILKING EQUIPMENT OR DRINKING WATER.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** Malathion is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates and the aquatic life stages of amphibians. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (i.e. swamps, bogs, marshes, and ponds). Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in areas near the application site. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Do not apply in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons. Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing until sprays have dried.

**IF ON SKIN:** Wash immediately with plenty of water. Wash affected areas with soap and water.

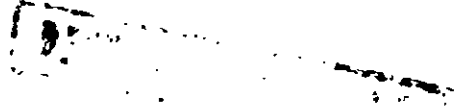
**IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
