

For use in nonfood areas indoors and outside premises of hotels, motels, prepackaged, apartment buildings, commercial offices, institutional and storage buildings, recreational buildings, boats, ship cabins and hospitals. In hospitals, remove patients prior to treatment. Ventilate room for two hours before returning patients.

This product can be used in nonfood areas only such as corridors, offices, lobbies, lavatories, garages, utility rooms, storage rooms and basements. Of packaging and processing plants, milk handling areas of milk plants, milk storage rooms, egg processing plants, supermarkets, restaurants, bottling plants, canteens, hotel and food mills and laundries. Also for use in and around campers, mobile homes, buses and cars. This product can be used in cargo planes, tractors, boxcars and ship cargo holds only if the vehicles are not used for transport of food or food products at any time. Also for use in dog kennels and horse stables. Do not spray on horses and dogs. Do not spray on dog and horse food or feed items. One gallon of spray is sufficient to treat 1500 linear feet with a 6 inch spray. For contact and residual spray, use State Formula 401 Ready Kill with Dursban * without diluting. Indoor use of State Formula 401 Ready Kill with Dursban * is limited to spot treatment and/or crack and crevice treatment only.

CONTACT SPRAY KILLS AND REDUCES INFESTATIONS: Use as a spot treatment to kill live insects listed on the center panel of this label. When possible spray directly on pests to reduce infestations. Apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators and other appliances, baseboards and storage areas. Apply until area is wet, but not to the point of runoff. Repeat as necessary.

FLAAR, BROWN DOTS AND LONG STAR TICKS: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and retaining quarters nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where the pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. **DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.** To control the source of your flea infestation, treat your pets with a product registered for animal application, such as State 797-A Powdered Insecticide.

CARPET BEETLES AND CLOTHES MOTHS: Do not spray clothing with this product. Do not allow clothing to contact areas where this product has been used. Spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting, rugs and closets. Make localized application to the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, crevices, closets and infested areas of shelving and/or wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOOR PESTS

PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS: Use State Formula 401 Ready Kill with Dursban * to control ants, cover mees, crickets, earwigs, millipedes, and sowbugs by application as a spray or with a paint brush outside surface of buildings, including porches, screens, window frames, eaves, patios, garages, refuse dumps and other areas where these pests congregate or have been seen. Do not treat or allow the spray to contact plants (lawns, flowering plants, shrubs, trees, evergreens, etc.) because of possible injury. Repeat treatment as needed to maintain effectiveness.

NOTE: To help prevent infestation of buildings by ants, crickets, earwigs, and sowbugs (millipedes), treat a band of soil 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the buildings, also the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where pests are active and may find entrance.

TO CONTROL FIRE ANTS: Thoroughly wet the mound and surrounding area to a 4 foot diameter with Formula 401 Ready Kill with Dursban *. For best results apply in cool weather (55-80°F) in the early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear. Do not disturb the mound prior to treatment. If possible, treat all mounds in the vicinity and treat all colonies which may not as yet have constructed a mound.
