DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with it's labeling. State Veterinarian Disinfectant is designed specifically for use on cages, operating tables, floors, walls, chicken coops, crates, furniture, and feeding and watering equipment in animal laboratories, animal hospitals, animal quarters, kennels, pet shops and zoos.

DISINFECTION: For disinfecting, add at least 2 ounces of State Veterinarian Disinfectant to one gallon of water, apply solution with a sponge, mop, cloth or mechanical sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet 10 minutes and then let air dry.

For heavily soiled or contaminated area, a precleaning step is recommended. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

For feeding and water equipment, RINSE WITH POTABLE WATER after disinfecting.

MILDEWSTAT: To control mold and mildew on precleaned hard non-porous surfaces add 2 ounces to 1 gallon of water. Apply solution with a cloth, mop, or sponge making sure to wet all surfaces completely. Let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution for each use. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.

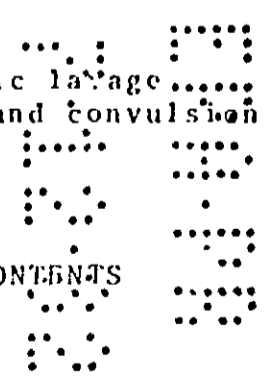
In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of

State Veterinarian Disinfectant is formulated to disinfect, sanitize, deodorize and clean inanimate hard surfaces in animal labs, animal hospitals and kennels. State Veterinarian Disinfectant also deodorizes the areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, and any other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

DISINFECTION: When used as directed, State Veterinarian Disinfectant demonstrates effective disinfection against the following:

Pseudomonas aeruginosa PRD-10
Escherichia coli
Klebsiella pneumoniae
Salmonella shuttmuelleri
Salmonella choleraesuis

Streptococcus faecalis
Shigella dysenteriae
Enterobacter aerogenes
Staphylococcus aureus
Brevibacterium ammoniagenes

HOSPITAL DISINFECTIONS: When used as directed, State Veterinarian Disinfectant is an effective disinfectant against Pseudomonas aeruginosa in animal hospitals for operating tables and equipment.

VIRUCIDAL* ACTIVITY: The product when used at general disinfection dilution rates on environmental inanimate hard surfaces exhibits effective virucidal activity against Canine distemper, Pseudorabies virus, Vaccinia virus, Influenza A₂, Herpes Simplex, and Adeno Virus Type 5.

Efficacy tests have demonstrated that State Veterinarian Disinfectant is an effective bactericide, fungicide and virucide* in the presence of organic soil (5% blood serum).

MOLD AND MILDEWSTAT: State Veterinarian Disinfectant prevents and controls mold and mildew and the odors they cause on hard non-porous inanimate surfaces.

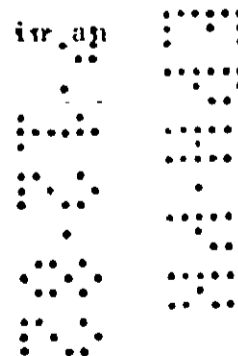

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS

For Plastic Containers:


