

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**General Classification**

State FDX "Terg-o-cide in a can" is a foaming detergent-disinfectant used in hospitals, nursing homes, schools, homes, hotels and resorts. When used as directed, it is formulated to disinfect bathroom hard surfaces, toilet seats, sinks, tops, tables, chairs, telephones, bathroom shower stalls, tubs, showers, cabinets and bedsprings.

In addition, State FDX "Terg-o-cide in a can" demonstrates effective deodorization against *Streptococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, thus meeting the requirements for hospital use. It is an effective general disinfectant in the presence of organic soil (5% blood serum).

State FDX "Terg-o-cide in a can" is also fungicidal against *Pathogenic fungi* (Trichophyton) when used as directed on hard surfaces found in the bathroom, shower stall, and locker room or other clear hard nonporous surfaces commonly contacted by bare feet.
