CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid breathing mist. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces. Remove pets and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. DO NOT USE OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerate. Never use near ignition sources such as welding when the product is used in an area where vapors may become concentrated. Toxic gases could be generated on contact with open flame, hot surfaces, or other heat-producing conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray directly into the top of ant mound. Depress activator for 5 to 10 seconds. Repeat application at least 3 more times at locations around the mound. Do not disturb the mound more than necessary when treating to avoid migration of the ants and to obtain a more effective kill. Never apply State FIRE ANT KILLER directly to water or where possible contamination of water supplies could occur.

Buyer assumes all risks of use, storage, or handling of this material not in strict accordance with directions given herewith.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not store near heat or open flame. Keep in a locked storage area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate cans.

In food handling areas, food should be removed or covered previous to treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using. Apply only when facility is not in operation.
