DIRECTIONS FOR USE, Continued

Treat area thoroughly with particular attention to low and marshy places, shore lines, stagnant pools or ponds and shrubbery or vegetation where mosquitoes may rest. Apply at a rate of 20 fluid ounces per acre (or 0.5 fluid ounces per 1000 square feet).

Using truck mounted or mobile equipment, the above application rate will result if a 300 foot swath is laid down traveling at 5 m.p.h. and dispersing spray at a rate of 28 gallons per hour.

INDOOR USE: To control mosquitoes, houseflies, gnats, and small flying moths. Fill the room with mist, using one ounce per 1000-cubic feet of space. Keep room closed for 10 minutes. Vacate during treatment and ventilate before reoccupying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURE: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. and dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.
