DO NOT USE ON SILKS OR WOOLENS

FOR USE AS CHLORINE DISINFECTANT DIRECTIONS

LAWNS: For use as a bleach in laundering add one tablespoonful to each gallon of cold or warm water. Mix well. Soak clothes in bleaching solution about fifteen minutes, or just long enough to whiten them. Wash as usual and rinse thoroughly.

INK AND STARCH, STARCH, OR MILDEW: Soak white cotton or linen in cold water to remove any starch. Mix thoroughly three tablespoonsful bleach to each quart cold water. Soak from ten to fifteen minutes. Rinse thoroughly. If stains remain after removing ink soak by 1/2 cupfuls of vinegar.

DECOCALATE: Add full strength to drain pipes, tubs, sinks after rinsing with hot water. For refrigerators, thoroughly wash inside surfaces and shelves. Keep wet for five minutes with a solution of three tablespoonsful to one quart warm water. Rinse and dry.

SWIMMING POOLS: To make the water hygienically cleaner (without harm plastic pools) Add 23 oz. (3-1/2 cups) Bleach to each 10,000 gallons of new water. Test water frequently and add BLEACH as required to maintain 0.5 to 1.0 p.p.m. Available Chlorine. Thoroughly mix BLEACH in 20 parts water and feed solution through a chlorinator, or dilute and撒播 over surface of pool.

DISINFECTANT: Dish cloths, handkerchiefs, diapers, etc. First wash in clean water. Immerse for 5 minutes in solution of 3 tablespoons of BLEACH to each quart of cold or lukewarm water. Rinse and dry.

GENERAL

All utensils, both dairy and household, which are to be disinfected should first be thoroughly washed with soap and warm water. Hypochlorites are rapidly inactivated by organic matter and will not do effect when used in wash water. After washing utensils submerge for at least two minutes in a solution of 200 P.P.M. (see table above)
