

**DO NOT USE ON SILKS OR WOOLENS**

**FOR USE AS CHLORINE DISINFECTANT**

**DIRECTIONS**

**LAUNDRY:** For use as a bleach in laundering, add one tablespoonful to each gallon of cold or warm water. Mix well. Leave clothes in bleaching solution about fifteen minutes, or just long enough to whiten them. Wash as usual and rinse thoroughly.

**STAIN AND STAIN REMOVER, OR MILDEW:** Soak white cottons or nans in cold water to remove any starch. Mix thoroughly three tablespoonful bleach to each quart cold water. Soak from ten to fifteen minutes. Rinse thoroughly. If stains remain after removing ink spots, try lemon juice or vinegar.

**DISINFECTANT:** Add full strength to drain pipes, tubs, or sinks after rinsing with hot water. For refrigerators, thoroughly wash inside surfaces and shelves. Keep wet for five minutes with a solution of three tablespoonful to one quart warm water. Rinse and dry.

**SWIMMING POOLS:** To make the water hygienically cleaner (Will not harm plastic pools) Add 23 oz. (3-1/2 cups) Bleach to each 10,000 gallons of new water. Test water frequently and add BLEACH as required to maintain 0.5 to 1.0 p.p.m. Available Chlorine. Thoroughly mix BLEACH in 20 parts water and add solution through a chlorinator, or dilute and scatter over surface of pool.

DILUTION TABLE	
100 P. P. M.	1 oz. to 3 gal. water
200 P. P. M.	1 oz. to 1-1/2 gal. water
400 P. P. M.	1 oz. to 3 qts. water
P. P. M. = parts available chlorine per million parts of water.	
2 TABLESPOONS = 1 OUNCE	

**DISINFECTANT:** Dish cloths, handkerchiefs, diapers, etc. First wash in clean water. Immerse for 5 minutes in solution of 3 tablespoons of BLEACH to each quart of cold or lukewarm water. Rinse and dry.

**GENERAL**

All utensils, both dairy and household, which are to be disinfected should first be thoroughly washed with soap and warm water. Hypochlorites are rapidly inactivated by organic matter and will not disinfect when used in wash water. After washing utensils submerge for at least two minutes in a solution of 200 P.P.M. (see table above)

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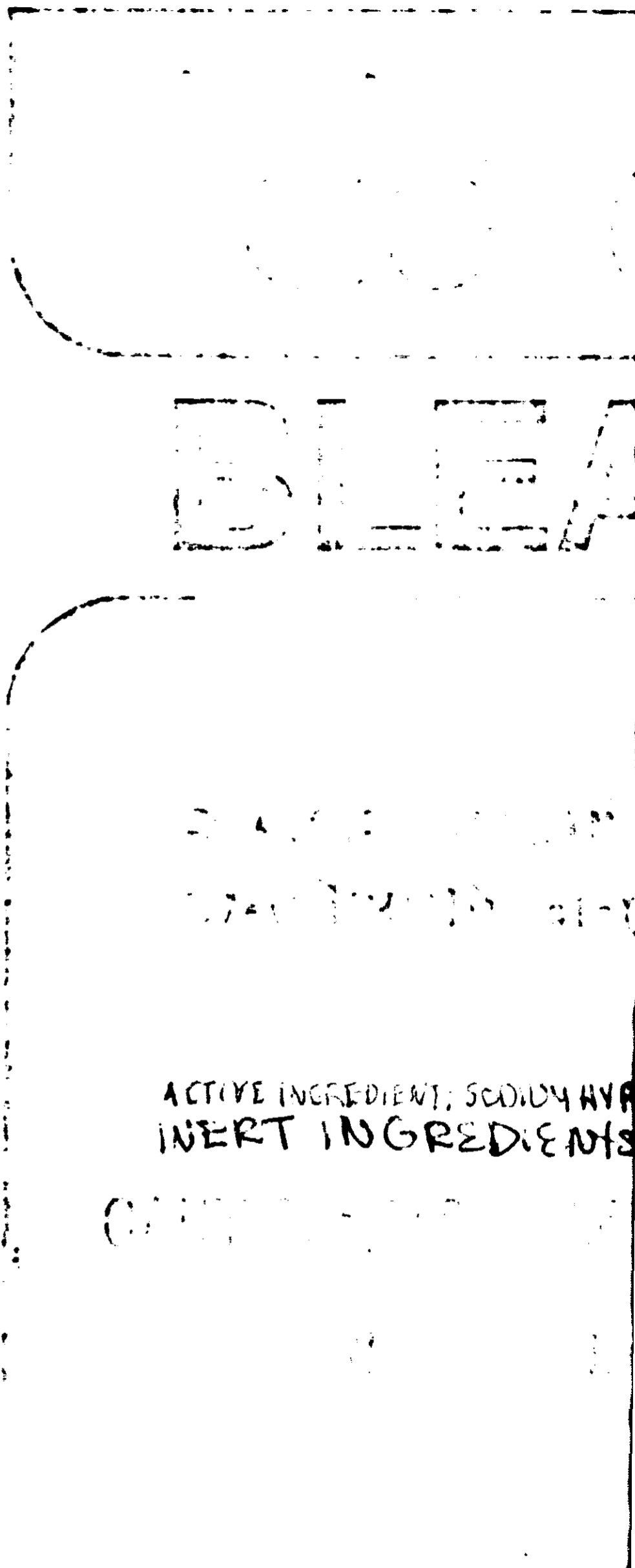

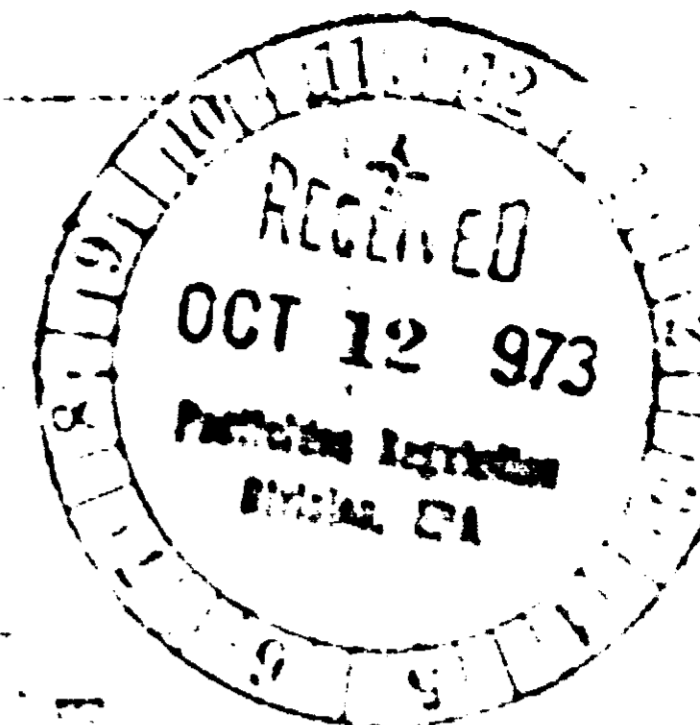
