

STAIN REMOVER

TOILET BOWLS - Pour one bottle over the trap with a scrub.

Pour two cups of cleaner around edge of bowl and allow to remain for several minutes. Scrub thoroughly with a stiff brush. If toilet flush ring and around inside surface of bowl repeat operation until cleaned. After cleaning, rinse bowl by flushing.

URINALS - Saturate ring or brush with cleaner and scrub urinal until stains or odor-causing bacteria have disappeared. To remove odorous scale and algae growth, pour four ounces into urinal and allow to remain as long as possible.

DO NOT GET THIS CHEMIST

WARNING:

ANTIDOTE:

Internal - call a physician immediately. Drink a teaspoonful or more of magnesia, chalk, or small pieces of soap, softened with water in milk or raw egg white.

External - Eyes - Wash with water for 15 minutes. Get prompt medical attention. Skin - Wipe off the acid gently, immediately flood the surface with water, using soap freely, then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.
