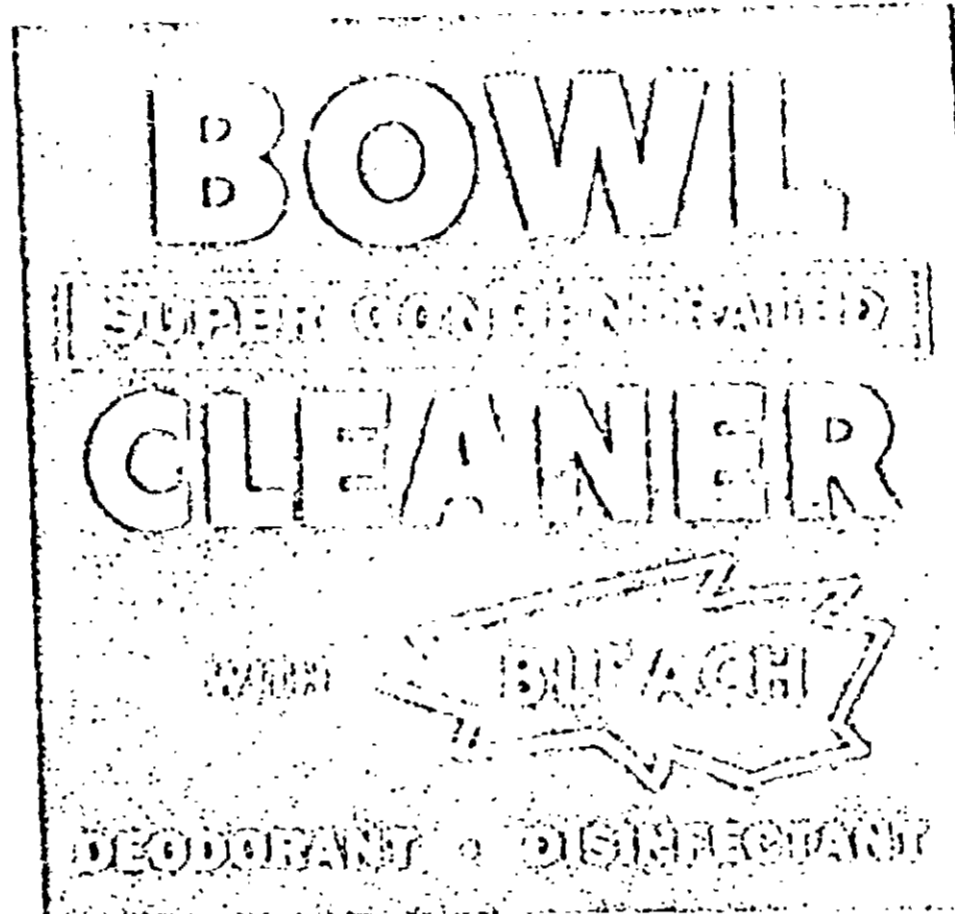

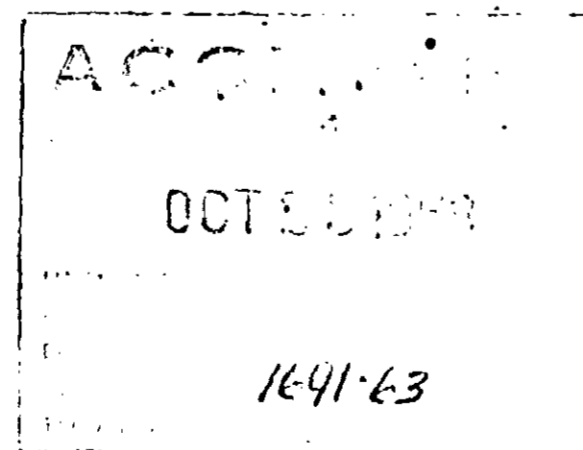

USE ONE TROUBLE-SHOOTER OF QUIST CLEANER

PERIODICALLY

TOILET BOWLS - Pour water over the trap with a scrub.

Pour two cups of cleaner around edge of bowl and allow to remain for several minutes. Scrub thoroughly with a stiff brush under flush ring and around inside surface of bowl. Repeat operation until cleaned. After cleaning, rinse bowl by flushing.

URINALS - Saturate mop or brush with cleaner and scrub urinal until stains or discoloration have disappeared. To remove odorous scale and algae growth, pour four ounces into urinal and allow to remain as long as possible.

DO NOT USE WITH SODIUM
HYPOCHLORITE, BLEACH,
HYDROGEN PEROXIDE & OTHERS.

WARNING:

ANTIDOTE:

Internal: call a physician immediately. Drink a teaspoonful or more of magnesia, chalk, or small pieces of soap, softened with water in milk or raw egg white.

External: Eyes - Wash with water for 15 minutes. Get prompt medical attention. Skin - Wipe off the acid gently, immediately flood the surface with water, using soap freely, then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.
