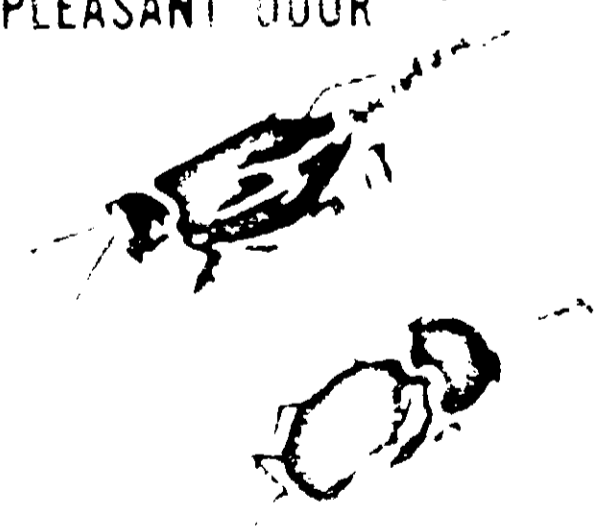

### DIRECTIONS

To Spray: Remove protective cap, push valve button to spray, hold nozzle perpendicular and aim spray opening away from you. Push button to release mist. Always use in open area to prevent contact with any surface.

For Flying Insects: Mosquitoes, house flying moths, flies, sand flies, etc. spray toward the upper portion of the room. Spray where insects are present. Repeat for 10 minutes. Repeat every 2-3 days for similar insects. Repeat every 3-4 days.

Blatting Insects: Crawling water bugs, silverfish, fleas, etc. spray directly on the insects. Repeat every 2-3 days. Repeat every 3-4 days.

Bedbugs: Spray directly on the insects. Repeat every 2-3 days. Repeat every 3-4 days.

Ants: Spray directly on the insects. Repeat every 2-3 days. Repeat every 3-4 days.

Outdoor Use: Spray directly on the insects. Repeat every 2-3 days. Repeat every 3-4 days.
