DIRECTIONS FOR HOUSEHOLD AND INDUSTRIAL USE

Roaches and Waterbugs: Use 6-7 ounces of the concentrate to 1 gallon of water. Thoroughly spray infested cracks and other hiding places and adjacent exposed surfaces where roaches and waterbugs will crawl when they come out of hiding. Repeat application as often as necessary.

Silverfish: Use 6-7 ounces of concentrate to 1 gallon of water. Thoroughly spray baseboards, areas behind shelving, book cases, and storage areas. Repeat application as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

Ants: Use 6-7 ounces of concentrate to 1 gallon of water. Thoroughly spray ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where the pests may enter. Treat openings around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets, and baseboards where ants come into rooms from wall spaces and partitions. Repeat application as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

Carpet Beetles: Use 6-7 ounces of concentrate to one gallon of water. Thoroughly spray infested areas of carpets, localized areas of floors, and baseboards and into cracks and under carpets where these pests may be found. If necessary treat floors, baseboards, and shelves of closets. Repeat application as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

Crickets: Use 6-7 ounces of concentrate to a gallon of water. Thoroughly spray baseboards, floors of closets, and storage places, and other hiding places. Repeat application as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

Flies: Use 6-7 ounces of concentrate to a gallon of water. Thoroughly spray areas where flies are breeding and feeding. Repeat application as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

Thoroughly spray infested cracks and other hiding places and adjacent exposed surfaces where roaches and waterbugs will crawl when they come out of hiding. Repeat application as often as necessary.

Silverfish: Use 6-7 ounces of concentrate to 1 gallon of water. Thoroughly spray baseboards, areas behind shelving, book cases, and storage areas. Repeat application as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

Ants: Use 6-7 ounces of concentrate to 1 gallon of water. Thoroughly spray ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where the pests may enter. Crickets: Use 6-7 ounces of concentrate to a gallon of water. Thoroughly spray baseboards, floors of closets, and storage places, and other hiding places. Repeat application as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

Flies: Use 3 ounces of concentrate to a gallon of water. Indoors: Thoroughly and repeatedly spray doors, around windows and other areas frequented by this insect. Outdoors: Thoroughly spray screens, window frames, doorsills, and selected areas of porches where these insects tend to alight or congregate. Repeat applications as often as necessary to obtain maximum value.

Bedbugs: Use 3 ounces of concentrate to a gallon of water. Apply lightly to all mattress surfaces in sufficient quantity to "mist" the fabric, and apply generously to beds and woodwork, with special care taken to wet all possible hiding places.

C A U T I O N

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe spray mist or dust. Do not get in the eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after using. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Malathion can cause symptoms similar to those caused by other organic phosphate compounds although much greater exposures are required. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine is antidotal.

W A R N I N G !

Spray should not be applied in conjunction with sulfur spray, or if sulfur residue is present. Keep containers closed and away from heat and open flame. Keep out of reach of children.
