

PANEL NO. 1

DIRECTIONS:

Mix the contents of this bottle with 4½ pounds of bait material such as breakfast rolled oats or bread crumbs mixed with bacon grease or corn oil, diced fresh coconut, fish, ground meat, or other appropriate materials.

Do not use foods which will be attractive to children, such as cookies, candy, nuts, etc.

USE:

Pour bait in dry shallow containers. Place where rodents or signs of rodents (droppings, gnawings, holes) have been seen. Maintain stations until all signs of rodents have disappeared.

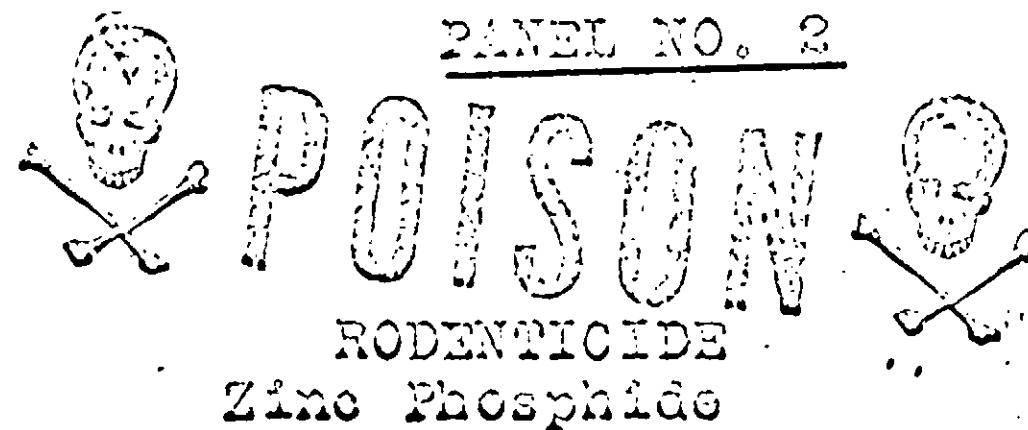
HOUSE MOUSE AND RAT CONTROL (1% BAIT)

Place rounded teaspoon piles of bait at 8 to 10 foot intervals where mice and rats feed, water, or travel.

Baits must be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets, and domestic animals, or in tamper-proof bait boxes.

Collect and destroy uneaten baits ^{and dead rodents} after completion of the control program.

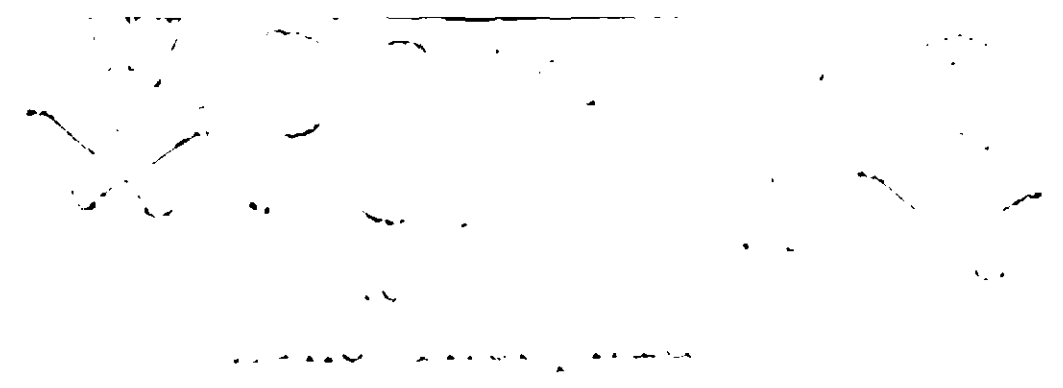
ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:
