- DIRECTIONS**
1. If algae growth is observed, add 1 gallon SANTROL ALGAECIDE for each 20,000 gallons of water to kill and control those algal species most commonly found in swimming pools.
 2. When existing growth is dead and algae have withered, clean the pool, draining and refilling if necessary, then add 1 gallon SANTROL ALGAECIDE per 50,000 gallons of water.
 3. If algae growth is absent, use 1 gallon SANTROL ALGAECIDE for each 50,000 gallons of water.
