DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open flames prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protection required as to prevent contact with the product. Cover the spilled areas with amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, etc. Sweep the contaminated absorbent into a shovel and put the sweep into a drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a glass container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product should be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or otherwise approved by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (cont'd.)

FOR DISINFECTING FLOORS AND WALLS: After surfaces have been cleaned, apply a solution containing 1½ ounces of Formula 866 to each gallon of water. Scrubbing, spraying or wiping in such a manner as to wet surfaces of contaminated surfaces or in hospital applications, dilute 3 ounces of Formula 866 to each gallon of water and apply as above.

FOR DISINFECTING WASH BASINS, SHOWERS, TOILET SEATS AND SINKS: Spray, swab or hand wash with a solution containing 2 ounces of Formula 866 to each gallon of water.

FOR DEODORIZING: Dilute 3 ounces of Formula 866 to each gallon of water and apply to air or onto surfaces to be deodorized.
