DIRECTIONS:

For control of bacterial and fungal slime in pulp, paper and paperboard mills, use 1.2 to 1.5 pounds of NALCO D-2303 per ton of pulp or paper, dry basis, depending upon degree of contamination.

Feed NALCO D-2303 from drum through a chemical proportioning tank. Feeding equipment should be stainless steel, polyethylene, polypropylene, or Teflon. Application of NALCO D-2303 may be anywhere in the system prior to sheet formation or to the recirculating white water. Recommended in-plant storage is six months.
