DIRECTIONS: For control of sucrose utilizing bacteria in raw sugar processing, and to keep screens and other equipment free of slime deposits, use 10-20 ppm of NALCO 247 based on weight of raw cane or beets processed. Feed NALCO 247 directly from the drum, or diluted with water, continuously to the raw juice. A chemical metering pump may be employed with NALCO 247. Further directions for use are found in the NALCO 247 Product Bulletin or collateral label.

NOTE: NALCO 247 IS INTENDED FOR INDUSTRIAL USE ONLY. Do not apply to potable or domestic water systems.

Apply this product only as specified on this label. Do not reuse this drum. Destroy when empty.
