The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. Revise the statement "Causes severe eye and skin damage" to read "Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage." This statement must be placed before the statement "Harmful if swallowed."
 - b. Remove the colon (:) from the signal word "DANGER" (front panel). The signal word must also be centered on the front panel.
 - c. Include the Physician statement to read:

Note to Physician:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate gastric lavage.

2. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

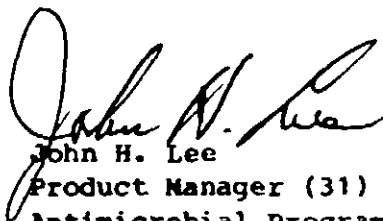

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND
DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER:

**HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED, INHALED
OR ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN CAUSES
SEVERE EYE AND SKIN DAMAGE.**

Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Keep away from heat and open flame. Keep container closed when not in use. Avoid breathing of vapor. Use with adequate ventilation. Do not take internally.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or mixate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

METAL CONTAINERS: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

PLASTIC CONTAINERS: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
