PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

DANGER:

HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED, INHALED, OR ABSORBED THROUGH THE SKIN. CAUSES SEVERE EYE AND SKIN DAMAGE. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

To inhibit sludge formation, to disperse existing sludge and to control filter-plugging bacteria and fungi in marine, automotive, trucking, agricultural and other industrial and/or commercial fuel oil storage tanks such as those associated with stand-by generator systems and steam producing boiler systems so long as treated fuel oil combustion products are not released directly into rooms or other spaces occupied by man or animals, use one gallon of FIRE • PREP 1000 per 1000 gallons of diesel fuel oil. Higher dosages may be required to completely inhibit some bacteria not considered to be factors in filter plugging.

Feed FIRE • PREP 1000 by means of proportioning pump or syphon type feeder directly from drum or other container to the fuel oil as it is pumped into storage tanks.
