DIRECT

Use in hospitals, public restrooms, barber and beauty shops, restrooms for general disinfection of plastic, porcelain, synthetic and furnishing.

FOR DISINFECTION

1. Flush away surface soil.
2. Clean with a solution of 1 part per gallon of water.
3. Rinse with clear water.
4. Apply disinfecting solution to all surfaces. For non-porous surfaces, make a disinfecting solution of 1 part per gallon of water. For porous surfaces, make a disinfecting solution of 1 part per gallon of water.
5. Surfaces contacting food should be washed with detergent and rinsed with water.

FOR DECONTAMINATION

For garbage cans and similar containers, use a solution of 12 ounces per gallon of water.

FOR MILDewing

Use on enamel, porcelain, and other surfaces. Follow directions. Repeat treatment every seven days.
