"alkyl as in fatty acids of coconut oil.
 - b. Since your last accepted label is dated March 19, 1974, you may choose to update your label to:
 - (1) Include the above correction,
 - (2) Reflect the current concept of "Format Labeling,"
 - (3) Include the appropriate container and pesticide storage and Disposal headings and instructions - See FR Notice 83-3.
