

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**IF SWALLOWED:** Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician at once. Never give an unconscious person anything by mouth.

**IF INHALED:** Remove immediately to fresh air. If not breathing, apply artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Call a physician.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this pesticide in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

For algal control in industrial water towers use 1.0 gallon of NALCO 7329 per 10,000 gallons system (200 ppm of product) initially. Repeat applications as needed to maintain desired degree of control. For badly fouled systems use 1.0 gallon NALCO 7329 per 10,000 gallons water (100 ppm of the product) to maintain control. Badly fouled systems in jeopardy of failure require cleaning of systems with a strong detergent. Technical assistance is available from NALCO.

For wood protection in industrial recirculating systems use 1.0 gallon of NALCO 7329 per 10,000 gallons of water (200 ppm of product) two to three months or more. Badly fouled systems require wood protection dosage maintenance dosage for maintenance.

Feed NALCO 7329 directly into the system where it is normally distributed.

**NOTE:** NALCO 7329 is for TRIAL USE ONLY. Do not use in domestic water systems.
