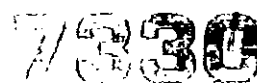

SUBSEQUENT DOSE

When microbial control is evident, add 1.28 to 1.58 lbs (19 to 28 fluid ounces) of NALCO 7330 per 1000 gallons of water in the system weekly or as needed to maintain control. Badly fouled systems must be cleaned before treatment is begun. NALCO 7330 weighs 8.4 lbs per gallon.
