1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes and submit the chemistry information listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 1706-169."
 - b. This product is not cleared under the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act for use in the manufacture of paper and paperboard that contact food. Therefore, the following disclaimer must be added to the Directions For Use: This product is not to be used in the manufacture of paper and paperboard products intended for food contact surface uses.
 - c. According to your Confidential Statement of Formula you may declare no more than 5.2% of Bis(trichloromethyl)sulfone. According to our records "N-1386 Hexylene Glycol," EPA Registration No. 476-2152, is 34.3% active.

- f. Under Paint Films, clarify whether the use is intended for protection of the dried paint film or paint in the container and whether the intended pests are mold and mildew (on dried paint films) or fungal deterioration or spoilage (in the container).
- g. Expand the ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS Statement to read as follows:

This pesticide is toxic to fish.
