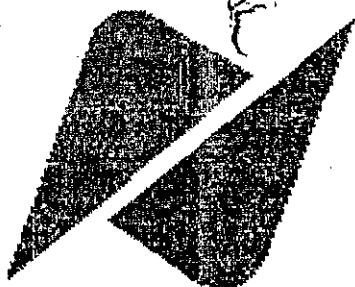

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

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It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Technical assistance in applying NALCON 7642 for control of bacterial and fungal slime as described below is available from your Nalco representative.

PULP & PAPER MILLS:

For control of fungi, bacteria, and associated slime in pulp, paper or paperboard systems, use 0.25-1.5 lbs NALCON 7642 per ton of total paper (dry basis) production. Intermittent or continuous application to thick or thin stock has proven most effective. Typical feed cycle would be 1 hour on at a dosage of 4.2 lbs/ton and then 7 hours off to give a total average feed of 0.5 lbs/ton fiber.

For application as a preservative in an additive system, NOT REQUIRING FDA STATUS, add NALCON 7642 directly to the system to be preserved at a dosage of 250-750 ppm. The exact dosage necessary for preservation will depend upon the components and local storage conditions. Dosage rates should be determined by actual tests.

Feed NALCON 7642 directly from the bulk container or dispersed in water. Application may be anywhere in the system prior to sheet formation or to the recirculating white water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Wastes representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
