# HY-PHEN DISINFECTANT

**CLEANS, SANITIZES, DEODORIZES AND DISINFECTS**

## DIRECTIONS

To clean, disinfect and deodorize walls, floors, tables and sinks, wash with solution containing two ounces of HY-PHEN per gallon of water.  
Disinfection in hospitals, morgues, embalming rooms: for disinfection of walls, floors and other non-porous surfaces, after cleaning, use two ounces of HY-PHEN in one gallon of water. For disinfection of porous and heavily contaminated surfaces use four ounces of HY-PHEN to one gallon of water. To clean embalming instruments: remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits prior to application of the disinfectant. Wipe articles, clean and soak for ten minutes in a solution containing two tablespoons of HY-PHEN per quart of water.

## DANGER KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Severe eye irritant. May cause eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

## FIRST AID

In case of eye contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, then promptly get medical attention. In case of skin contact flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting; drink large quantities of fluids and get medical attention immediately.
