DIRECTIONS

To clean, disinfect and deodorize walls, floors, tables and sinks, wash with solution containing 2 ounces of HY-PHEN per gallon of water. Disinfection in hospitals, morgues, embalming rooms: for disinfection of walls, floors and other non-porous and heavily contaminated surfaces use 4 ounces of HY-PHEN to one gallon of water. To clean embalming instruments: remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits prior to application of the disinfectant. Wipe articles, clean and soak for ten minutes in a solution containing 2 tablespoons HY-PHEN per quart of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, or feed, by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray, mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Plastic containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

DANGER—KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Severe eye irritant. May cause eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID

In case of eye contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, then promptly get medical attention. In case of skin contact flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting, drink large quantities of fluids and get medical attention immediately.
