DIRECTIONS

This copper paint will protect the bottoms of boats used in salt water from tere-dos, worms, barnacles, and other fouling. For best results the surface should be clean, dry, and free of any loose or scaling paint. This copper paint is suitable for wood or metal boats.

NEW WORK: Metal hulls should be cleaned by wire brushing, chipping, and scraping to remove all rust and scale. Prime by applying 2 coats of Anti-Corrosive paint according to directions on the can. When dry apply 2 coats of this copper paint allowing 4 hours drying between coats. Allow overnight if possible but at least 4 hours drying before returning the boat to the water.

Wooden boats should be clean and dry. The first coat should be thinned by adding 1/2 to 1 pint BLP MoPaxOI Low Odor Thinner 75-1 to a gallon. Allow 4 hours to dry and apply a second coat as it comes from the can. (MoPaxOI Thinner or turpentine may be used sparingly to thin if necessary.) Allow overnight if possible but at least 4 hours drying before returning to the water.

REPAINT WORK: Immediately after removing from the water the hull should be thoroughly scrubbed with a stiff brush or broom working in running water from a hose. When all the scum and slime is thus removed allow the hull to dry. Barnacles and grass should be removed by scraping and then the hull should be sanded to remove all loose and scaling paint.

METAL HULLS: Any rusted metal should be spot primed with Anti-Corrosive paint after all rust has been removed. The entire hull should receive one or two coats of Anti-Corrosive paint depending on the condition of the previous coat of paint and finish as is new work above.

WOODEN HULLS: After the hull has been washed, dried, and sanded apply one or two coats of copper paint as under new work above.

CAUTION: Use MoPaxOI Thinner or turpentine for thinning. Do not use Linseed Oil.
