

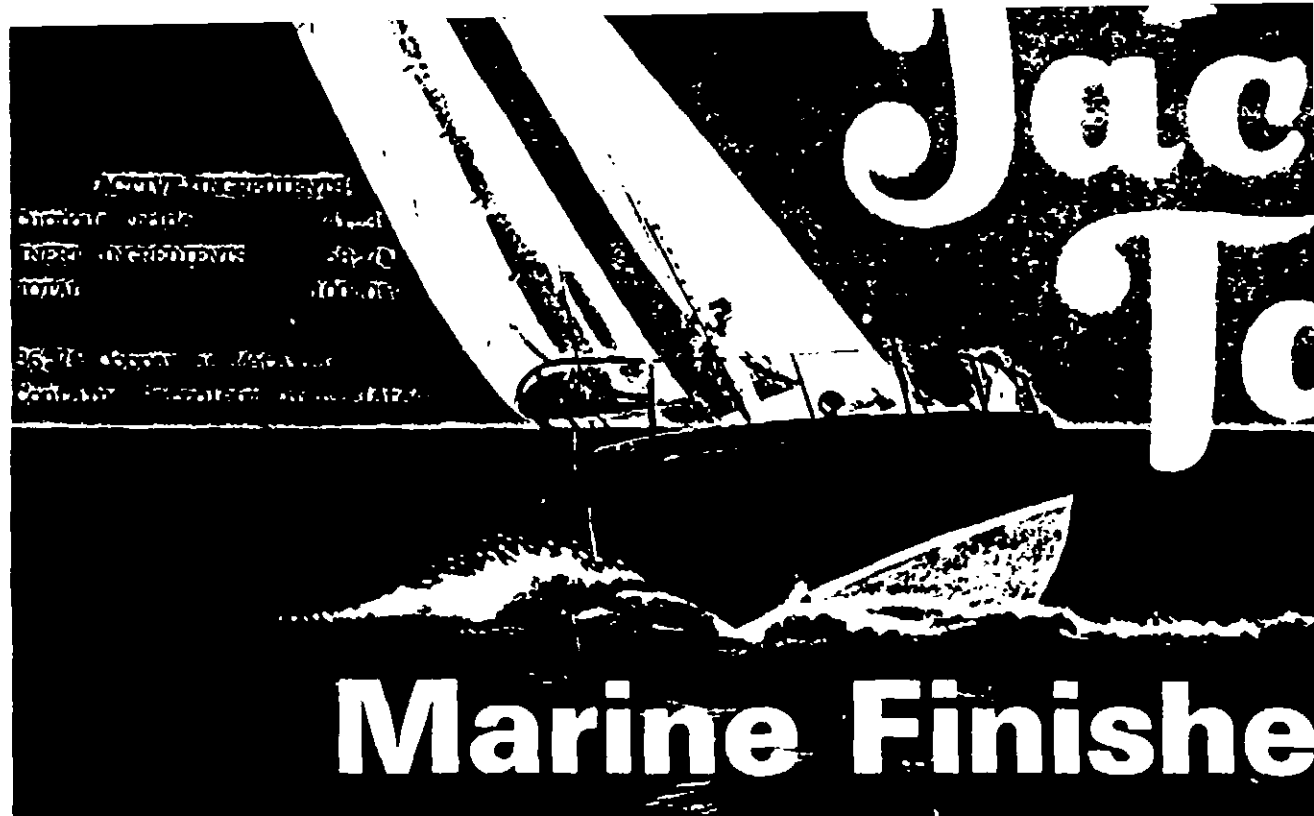

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This paint provides very good resistance to fouling by barnacles, tube worms and other salt water invertebrates and retards the heavy build up of algae and slime. Dub-L-Cop Copper Paint 473-38 Blue is a traditional rosin-based bottom paint for anti-fouling protection on wood and steel vessels. Dub-L-Cop Copper paint 473-38 Blue may be applied by roller, brush or spray techniques. It is very important to shake or stir thoroughly before each use to disperse any of the heavy copper pigment which may have settled. Use BLP MoPax01 75-1 for cleanup and when necessary for thinning. One gallon covers approximately 200-250 square feet when applied in 2 coats. Allow a minimum of 4 hours dry time after each coat of Dub-L-Cop Copper Paint 473-38 Blue. It is preferable that the final coat be allowed to dry overnight before launching. Conditions of high humidity or low temperature increase the dry time.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR STEEL HULLS

Repaint Work: If the old coating is sound, clean the surface by scrubbing it free of all foreign matter. When dry, properly prepare and spot prime as indicated under New Work: Finish by applying two 2.0 mil coats of Dub-L-Cop Copper Paint 473-38 Blue. New Work: Hull should be cleaned by scraping, wire brushing or sandblasting to remove all rust and scale. Prime by applying 3 coats of Anti-Corrosive Primer 409-68 following directions on the can. Allow to dry overnight, then apply two 2.0 mil coats of Dub-1-Cop Copper Paint.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE

Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not transfer contents to bottles or other unlabeled containers.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
