BLP Weather Protector Exterior Wood Stain and Preservative can be mixed with Tran-Stain base to produce a semitransparent stain which allows the grain and natural beauty of the wood to show through. The Color Studio Base provides hundreds of color possibilities and should be used only after the addition of Color Studio Colorants.

USE ONLY ON EXTERIOR SURFACES: BLP Weather Protector Exterior Wood Stain and Preservative is recommended for staining all bare new wood and previously unfinished wood such as roughsawn or smooth siding, clapboard, beams, shakes, shingles (not asbestos), and fences which are above ground. For wood at or below ground use BLP Cop-R-Tox 74-1. Where wood is to be used on the ground's surface (e.g. landscape timbers), this product may be used as a booster to pressure-treated wood. For maximum performance, wood to be stained should be dry and absorbent.

SURFACE PREPARATION: Proper surface preparation is absolutely essential for satisfactory results. Surfaces to be stained should be dry and free from mildew, dirt, dust, oil and other contaminants. To remove dirt and mildew wash with a solution of 1 quart household chlorine bleach, 1 cup non-ammoniated household detergent and 1 gallon of water (wear protective clothing, goggles and rubber gloves when using this potentially harmful solution). If mildew persists, retreat with 12 gallon household bleach in 12 gallon water. Rinse all surfaces thoroughly and allow to dry completely before staining.

APPLICATION: Make sure that stain is thoroughly mixed before use. Cut and machine wood prior to treatment if possible. Thoroughly stain joints, cracks, cut-ends, holes or other openings in wood. This product may be applied by brush; roller or spray gun. Stain a few boards at a time working from top to bottom or side to side in order to keep a "vet edge" and avoid lap marks. Avoid staining in direct sunlight, when temperature is below 50 degrees F. or if rain is threatening. Cover plants and shrubs to protect against possible injury from splash, drips or overspray. For it information of appearance and to maintain wood preservative properties, reapplication is recommended every 3 to 6 years.

This product is not recommended for use on primed, previously painted or otherwise sealed surfaces. Do not use on wood that will be in contact with food, feed, potable water or prolonged dermal (skin) contact. Due to the presence of petroleum distillates in this product, do not use where dairy cattle or livestock can come in contact with the treated wood.

APPROXIMATE COVERAGE: On rough wood 150 square feet per gallon; on smooth wood 250 square feet per gallon.

CLEANUP: Clean up drips, brushes and equipment with BLP MoPaxOl 75-1 or mineral spirits.

DRYING: BLP Weather Protector Exterior Wood Stain and Preservative dries to touch in 2-4 hours and to recoat or for use overnight under good drying conditions.
