## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

**DANGER!** Fatal if inhaled or swallowed. Causes irreversible eye damage or skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. ### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is not intended for use on food, feed, potable water, living plants, livestock, dairy animals or on wood surfaces where there will be frequent or prolonged skin contact. Application of this product may produce a strong, lingering unpleasant odor.

Zin-Tox Wood Preservative preserves and protects all types of unpainted wood surfaces, lumber, timbers, fish nets, rope or twine.

Fish net, rope or twine should be dipped in Zin-Tox Wood Preservative to thoroughly saturate the fibers.

Zin-Tox Wood Preservative may be applied by brushing freely, spraying or dipping in a tank or trough.

Zin-Tox Wood Preservative is most effective on unpainted, dry clean lumber as Zin-Tox Wood Preservative penetrates the pores and wood cells, filling with Zinc, preventing Termites, Decay, Fungus, Mildew.

Zin-Tox Wood Preservative may be painted over in 24 hours as it contains no creosote or tar products.

All wood which is to come in contact with the earth should receive two flowing coats by brush or spraying or be dipped for at least 5 minutes for each inch of thickness. Other surfaces require only one coat.

Zin-Tox Wood Preservative covers 300 square feet per gallon, one coat.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE** - Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in original container only. Close container after each use. Keep in a locked storage area, and out of the reach of children.
