USE FYNE-TEX ON WHITE AND FAST COLORS ONLY, DO NOT USE ON SILK OR WOOL OR ANY SPONGE EXCEPT VINYL

FYNE-TEX treatment is like sunning and airing, yet the action is more powerful and rapid. Like the sun, FYNE-TEX gives your laundry that fresh fragrance of outdoors. FYNE-TEX means death to many germs that lurk in the dark--germs that die when exposed to strong sunlight or to FYNE-TEX bleach. In fact, you may call it bottled sunshine!

LAUNDRY

FYNE-TEX BLEACHES white cottons and linens to snowy newness; FYNE-TEX DEODORIZES, makes clothes fresh and sweet smelling; and FYNE-TEX REMOVES STAINS at the same time (for stubborn stains, see below)

Soaking and Washing Suds - 1 tablespoonful FYNE-TEX bleach to one gallon of water. Mix well, add soap or detergent. Immerse laundry, wash or soak, and rinse. When laundry is placed in washer before water is added, as in some automatic machines, put recommended amount of FYNE-TEX in one quart of water, mix well, then add this to washer after laundry has been immersed.

Rinse Water - Use the above amount of bleach and soak laundry for fifteen minutes, then rinse.

STUBBORN STAINS

FYNE-TEX removes a variety of stains from white fabrics. Stains that remain after laundry bleaching may be removed by a stronger solution of FYNE-TEX.

2 tablespoonfuls FYNE-TEX bleach in one quart of water. Soak fabric in cold water for ten to fifteen minutes, immerse in FYNE-TEX solution for five to fifteen minutes, then rinse well in clear water. Repeat if necessary. Any remaining spots will probably be removed by lemon juice or vinegar.

DISHES, POTS AND PANS

FYNE-TEX DEODORIZES and DISINFECTS your dishes, prevents the transfer of odors from one dish to another (dinner plates to tea cups), FYNE-TEX REMOVES STAINS from your dishes and makes them sparkle.

Mild Solution for Everyday Use - 1 to 2 teaspoonfuls FYNE-TEX bleach to each gallon of suds. Wash dishes in customary fashion. Avoid prolonged immersion of silverware in any bleach solution. Stronger Solution - 1 to 2 tablespoonfuls FYNE-TEX to each gallon of water or suds. This solution should be used when there is severe illness in the house and it is important to prevent the spread of germs from one member of the family to another. This solution should be used to destroy very strong odors, such as cabbage, garlic, fish, onions and other foods, as well as to remove persistent stains from dishes.

REFRIGERATORS, SINKS, TILE, BATHTUBS, GARBAGE CANS

3 tablespoonfuls FYNE-TEX bleach to one quart of water. A stronger solution can be used. First thoroughly wash item, then keep wet for five minutes with FYNE-TEX bleach solution, rinse, dry and air. (In order to keep bleach solution from running down smooth surfaces of refrigerators, etc., add detergent to FYNE-TEX solution.)

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

FYNE-TEX bleach, undiluted, will irritate skin and eyes. If this occurs, rinse exposed parts thoroughly immediately after exposure. If accidentally taken internally, administer milk or egg white, or feed cooked cereal. Call Physician!

GARBAGE CANS
A hot bleach solution can be used. First thoroughly wash solution, rinse, dry and air. (In case of refrigerators, etc., add detergent to water.)
