GRANULAR CONCENTRATE

When used as directed this product is effective as a pool water disinfecting agent.

The filter system should be backwashed or properly cleaned and the pH adjusted between 7.4 and 7.6. It is recommended that the pool be stabilized with 40-50 p.p.m. trihydroxy triazine to nullify the disinfection effect of sunlight on chlorine. When using this product, both chlorine and trihydroxy triazine are being added to the water. However, it is necessary to initially stabilize pools with 40-50 p.p.m. trihydroxy triazine to effectively maintain the desired concentration of stabilizer. Follow directions for use on that product label.

DIRECTIONS: Use 4 ounces of GRANULAR CONCENTRATE per 10,000 gallons of water as an initial treatment. 4 ounces of this product in 10,000 gallons of water is equivalent to 2.0 p.p.m. Repeat as required to establish a residual of 1.0 to 1.5 p.p.m. available chlorine as determined by test kit. The regular use of the test kit will aid in determining when it is necessary to add more GRANULAR CONCENTRATE to maintain a residual of 1.0 to 1.5 p.p.m. available chlorine. An average is 2 to 3 ounces per 10,000 gallons of water, daily. The use of a quaternary ammonium type algaecide will complement this total program of swimming pool maintenance.

The residual is tested for proper chlorination to destroy algae growth. Use 1 pound of this product per 10,000 gallons of water.

NOTE: If the chlorine residual is 2.0 p.p.m. or above, the pool should not be used until the residual drops.

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by burying with water or burning. Stay away from smoke or fumes.

DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Can cause eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Irritates the nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. May cause burns to broken skin. Wash hands after handling.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, feed grain, cracker, corn or bread soaked in milk followed by water or cooking oil. In case of personal contact, remove excess material and flush skin or eye with cold water for at least 15 minutes. For eye contact, flush with water. Remove contact lenses and wash with water. Flush before reuse.

DANGER: STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT. Mix only with water. Do not use near food. Irritation by moisture, organic matter or other chemicals may create hazardous gases. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Do not use at 350-475 F with lubricants. In case of decomposition, if possible, place container in open area and flood with large amounts of water. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Do not use in ponds, lakes, streams, or other bodies of water. Do not allow product to enter water by use of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product to a surface and not to the water.

RINSE EMPTY CONTAINER THOROUGHLY WITH WATER AND DISCARD IT.
