When used as directed, SPA BROM is effective as a spa and hot tub disinfectant. SPA BROM is effective as a spa and hot tub disinfectant.

To keep SPA and HOT TUB water sparkling clean and odor free, place SPA BROM FEEDER STICKS in the water. Use one stick per 100 gallons of water to be treated. Replace with new sticks when SPA BROM has been dissolved. Maintain actual bromine residual between 1.0 and 5.0 ppm at all times.

The pump and filter should be operated for at least three hours every day. To conserve energy, use the heater only when the SPA or HOT TUB is to be used. Do not heat water above 105 F. Keep the SPA free of leaves and other debris. Backwash/clean the filter often. In heavily used commercial SPAS or HOT TUBS, drain and refill with fresh water every 4 days. In commercial SPAS or HOT TUBS with average use, drain and refill with fresh water every 8 days. Residential SPAS and HOT TUBS should be drained and refilled with fresh water every 60 days. Do not refill; clean the sides with a non-abrasive household cleaner and rinse thoroughly each time the SPA or HOT TUB is drained. Keep pH between 7.4 and 7.8 and never allow it to fall below 7.0. Use a good test kit often to test bromine residual and pH.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL - Keep product in closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat, open flame, and organic chemicals. Place in trash bin or dispose in approved landfill area. Do not use in areas where ventilation is poor.
