**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT.** If swallowed, drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician immediately. In case of skin contact, wash thoroughly with soap and water. In case of eye contact, flush eyes copiously with water for at least 15 minutes. Seek medical attention promptly.
