DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is effective in controlling micro-organisms such as bacteria, fungi and yeasts which cause deterioration of paper and paperboard products or articles molded from paper pulp. It may be added to the pulp stock in the beater or applied to the formed sheet by size press or rollcoater, or as a uniform spray. If the product is used as a beater additive, the degree of retention of the active ingredient will depend upon the nature of the other additives in the system. Technical service is available from the manufacturer of this product to assist customers in making the proper and most efficient use of the product.

FOOD PACKAGING. For paper and paperboard intended for use in contact with food, the rate of application of this product must be adjusted so that the amount of active ingredient (dodecylguanidine hydrochloride) retained does not exceed 0.4 percent by weight of the paper or paperboard.

PAPER AND PAPERBOARD PRODUCTS FOR INDUSTRIAL OR AGRICULTURAL USE. When the paper or paperboard product is to be subjected to excessive leaching as by rainfall or contact with ground water, a concentration of up to 0.8 percent of active ingredient (dodecylguanidine hydrochloride) by weight of the paper or paperboard may be required for effective microbial control.

DRUM DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.
