DIRECTIONS: Use 1/4 cup in one gallon water and wipe away household germs as you wipe away dirt. For really stubborn spots, wear rubber gloves and use direct from the bottle and rinse immediately. On food preparation surfaces, follow with potable water rinse. For effective disinfectant action, surfaces must be thoroughly wet with LEMONEX.

Add 1/4 cup of LEMONEX to laundry with regular soap or detergent to make clothes fresh and odor free.

INERT INGREDIENTS: 90.2% includes detergent, color and other grease cutting agents.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Dilute with water. For general cleaning, use 1/2 cup of cleaner per gallon of water. For heavy cleaning, use 1 cup of cleaner per gallon of water. For finished wood surfaces, use 1/4 cup of cleaner per gallon of water.

2. Apply to surface to be cleaned. Allow to stand for 5 to 10 minutes. Scrub with a brush or sponge. Rinse thoroughly with water.

FIRST AID:
