PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

WARNING

Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Pine Oil Disinfectant is a concentrated liquid and should be handled and diluted with care. Do not use stronger than directed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Give albuminous drinks, milk or white of egg. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If on Skin: Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water.

If in Eyes: Immediately flush eyes thoroughly with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Disinfecting and Cleaning: As a deodorant use 2 ounces (1/4 cupful) in 3 gallons of water. If stronger odor is desired, use more to suit conditions.

For disinfecting, add water to the disinfectant at the rate of one gallon of Pine Oil Disinfectant to 90 gallons of water (1 1/2 ounces to 1 gallon of water). Stir well after adding water. This solution acts as an effective disinfectant.

Use in Home, Sickroom and Kennels: Scrub or clean at a strength of 1 1/2 ounces to 1 gallon of water or at the rate of one gallon of Pine Oil Disinfectant to 90 gallons of water—this makes an effective disinfectant and deodorant. If premises simply require sweetening, 2 ounces to 3 gallons is sufficient.

Deodorant Sawdust: An excellent plan adopted by many kennels as well as Dog Shows is to mix one part Pine Oil Disinfectant with 20 parts water, then moisten sawdust with this solution. This treated sawdust spread about sweetens the atmosphere and makes a most desirable addition to any premises used to house animals.
