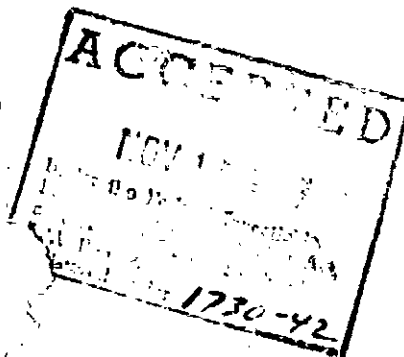

**DIRECTIONS:** Use 1/4 cup in one gallon water and wipe away household germs as you wipe away dirt. For really stubborn spots, wear rubber gloves and use directly from the bottle and rinse immediately. On food preparation surfaces, follow with potable water rinse. For effective disinfection, all surfaces must be thoroughly wet with LEMON SOL.

As a disinfectant, use with regular tap or detergent to make surfaces clean and safe.

**ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:** Ethyl alcohol 2-B-n-Alkyl (C14-60 - C16-30) - C12-5 - C18-5; 1-dimethyl benzyl ammonium chlorides - 175 - n-Alkyl (C12-5 - C14-60) - C15-17; 1-dimethyl ethyl benzyl ammonium chlorides - C12-5 - C14-60.
