DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO INSTALL: Clean toilet bowl thoroughly, especially under the rim, using a good cleaner/disinfectant such as PINE-SOL® brand. Remove top of tank. Lift seal from top of jar. Write the month of installation on seal and stick on outside of tank. To remove plug from center of lid, hold jar firmly on flat surface, press dot in center of plug to unlock tab, grasp tab and pull plug out. To install, flush toilet to drain out all water from tank, then place jar on tank bottom underneath the float with the hole facing upwards.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Before use, keep in cool dry well ventilated place away from flame or heat.

To Dispose: Wear rubber gloves. Remove top of tank, flush toilet to drain water. Avoid spilling by carefully pouring some of the liquid from the jar into the tank. Leave solids in jar. Wrap jar in plastic bag, seal and place in trash container. Wash hands thoroughly.

To open jar, remove this seal to expose special plug closure. To remove closure, hold jar firmly on flat surface, press dot in center of plug to unlock tab, grasp tab and pull plug out.
