Subject: Amendment - Administrative Label Changes  
Combat Roach Control System  
EPA Registration No. 1730-66  
Your Application Dated December 17, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. Delete the statement beginning, "Note: Pets may encounter a Combat bait tray. The bait . . . ."
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

In our October 4, 1985 letter we agreed to the administrative label changes per Robert Linkfield's letter of June 19, 1985. These changes involved only items 1 General, and 2 Directions, of your June 12, 1985 submission. Item 3 of same letter is presently under review.

1. Place all 8 bait trays in areas where you have actually seen roaches. For example, near or in floor drains and other exposed plumbing fixtures, near basement windows and doors, and where food is prepared and stored.
2. Use the entire contents of this carton at once. For best results, place next to walls and flush in corners, and at a coverage rate of 2 to 3 per 100 sq. ft.
3. If applying COMBAT® to vertical surfaces use enclosed stickers by removing paper backing from both sides. Stickers are not needed on all trays.

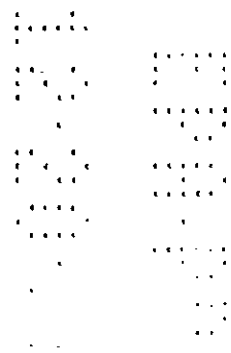

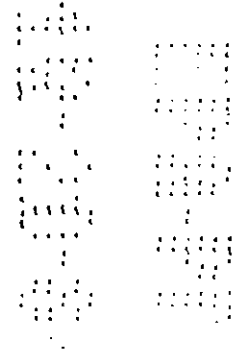

For larger kitchens or particularly heavy infestations, we strongly recommend using additional trays and placing at least 12 trays in the kitchen and 2 in each bathroom. If you discover roaches in other areas, such as the bedroom or utility room, you will need to obtain additional trays. For best results, place COMBAT next to walls and flush in corners.
