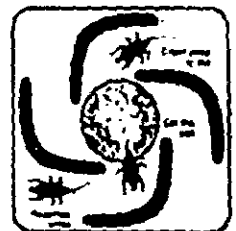
1. Break COMBAT bait trays apart from the plastic frame
2. Place all 12 trays in areas where you've seen roaches (see illustration). For 6 feet by 12 feet or smaller kitchens, use at least 10 trays in the kitchen and 2 in each bathroom. For more than one bathroom, you should use additional trays and place at least 10 in the kitchen and 2 in each bathroom. For larger kitchens or particularly heavy infestations, we strongly recommend using additional trays and placing at least 12 trays in the kitchen and 2 in each bathroom. If you discover roaches in other areas, such as the bedroom or utility room, you will need to obtain additional trays. For best results, place COMBAT next to walls and flush in corners.
3. If applying COMBAT on vertical surfaces, use enclosed stickers by removing paper backing from both sides. Stickers are not needed for all 12 trays.
4. Roaches will begin eating the bait immediately and you should expect to see fewer roaches within a week.
5. Replace all trays every 3 months to keep roaches from reappearing. Be sure to use the 3 month replacement reminder (enclosed).
