**FOR ROACHES, ANTS AND SILVERFISH:** Dust the powder liberally into all cracks and crevices from which these insects emerge or through which they may be entering the building. Pay particular attention to openings through walls and floors of heating cabinets and dust entry shelves. Repeat as often as necessary.

**TO KILL FLEAS AND LICE ON PET ANIMALS:** Dust the powder into the coat, working it into contact with the skin. The dead and stupefied insects should be brushed or combed from the coat, collected on paper and burned. Repeat as often as necessary.

**FOR LICE ON POULTRY AND PET BIRDS:** Dust the powder carefully into the feathers, under the wings, along the back and around the vent. Rub a pinch or two into the feathers of the head. Nests, roosts and runways should be thoroughly cleaned and dusted. In the case of caged birds, the perches and cage should be thoroughly dusted after destroying infested food or cuttlebone. Repeat as often as necessary.

**AGRICULTURAL INSECTS**

To control cabbage worm on cabbage, current worms on currents, Mexican bean beetle on beans, greenhouse leaf tier and certain aphids on asters, carnations, chrysanthemums, and certain other ornamentals-dust liberally the infected plants so as to contact the insects with the powder. Repeat application as necessary.
