Brown Dog Ticks: Thoroughly spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Applications should be repeated as infestations warrant, and as reinfestations occur. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat animal with this formulation.

Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps and Flying Moths *Outdoors*: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.
