

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE — (Non-Food Areas)

NON FOOD AREA — Use 1/2 oz. per gallon of water. Spray or dust surfaces where insects may be found. Apply to cracks and crevices, baseboards, corners, garage, etc. Apply to ceiling and walls around light fixtures, pipes, and other areas where insects hide out of sight. When dry, may cover Repeat treatment as required.

For Roaches, Ants, Wasps, Flies, Fleas, Spiders, Crickets, Lice, Fleas, Cockroaches, and Spiders. Apply 1/2 oz. per gallon of water to surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, in corners, sinks, stoves, etc. Use only where a zed area is infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as required.

Carpet Beetles, Moths. Apply 1/2 oz. per gallon of water to the floor and baseboards. Spray directly onto carpeting under carpets where insects may be found. Check between cracks and crevices, and infested areas of shelves. Repeat as necessary.

Brown Dog Ticks. Thoroughly spray infected areas around baseboards, window and door frames, walls, etc., sleeping quarters of household pets, and around doors, floors, and floor coverings. Apply 1/2 oz. per gallon of water repeating as infestation warrants. Do not wash dog after treatment. Fresh bedding should be placed on dog during following treatment. Do not treat animal with this formula.

Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps and Flying Moths, Houseflies. For outdoor use on lawns and around buildings apply 1/2 oz. of these insects. Spray onto surfaces of screens, lawns, window frames, or whatever these insects may frequent. Do not use this product on fruit trees, flowers, vegetables, and other plants. Apply the amount of water indicated above. SPRAY SELECTED SURFACES ONLY.

FOR ROACHES IN FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

FOOD HANDLING AREAS — Use 1/2 oz. per gallon of water than previously directed. In white bread and cake boxes, apply 1/2 oz. per gallon of water to the outside of the boxes. In meat, food, and produce boxes, apply 1/2 oz. per gallon of water to the outside of the boxes. **DO NOT SPRAY INSIDE THE BOXES.** If received in cardboard boxes, spray outside of boxes. If received in plastic bags, spray outside of bags. If received in boxes prepared with wax, spray outside of boxes. If received in plastic bags, spray outside of bags. If received in serving areas, when food is served, spray outside of bags.

For Roaches in Kitchens, Bathrooms, Laundry Rooms, and in Laundry, Dry Cleaning, and Laundry Establishments, and Crevices. Using dusting equipment, apply 1/2 oz. per gallon of water to cracks, crevices, and corners. Stream of water from stream of water. Do not spray on food, food preparation areas, or food containers. Do not spray on laundry, laundry rooms, or laundry equipment. After application, allow to dry. Evaluate effectiveness of treatment. If treatment is not effective, **ON PASTURE, GARDEN, AND LAWNS.** Apply 1/2 oz. per gallon of water to the product, foliage, and ground surface. Do not spray on manure piles, manure, or fertilizer. Do not spray on plants.

Areas of Roach Infestation. Apply 1/2 oz. per gallon of water to areas of roach infestation. **OTHER AREAS.** Apply 1/2 oz. per gallon of water to other areas.

SEPARATE AREA. Apply 1/2 oz. per gallon of water to areas such as the garage, basement, and other areas which may be infested with roaches. Do not spray on food, food preparation areas, or food containers. Do not spray on laundry, laundry rooms, or laundry equipment. After application, allow to dry. Evaluate effectiveness of treatment.
