

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

COCKROACHES
Cockroaches are found
in all types of homes
and buildings where
cockroaches normally are
found. These insects live
in cracks and crevices, in
kitchens and closets, at the
base of the wall, behind
baseboards, cabinet and
cabinets, refrigerators, stoves and
around pipes.

Apply in a manner to avoid
spray or mist contacting
food, feedstuff and water
supplies. Dishes and food
handling utensils should
be washed in soap and water
if they have become con-
taminated by the applica-
tion of this product.

Repeat treatment as needed.
NOTE: A period of 4 to 7
days after treatment is
normally required for maximum
effect on cockroaches.

Fish and Crustaceans may
be killed if their waters
are contaminated with this
product. Do not contaminate
water by cleaning equipment
or disposal of waste.

Promptly crush empty con-
tainers and bury them in
locations isolated from
water.

DIREBAN insecticide is a spray which
water or oil. Dilute one part oil emulsion
of DIREBAN in water or in a base oil such
as deodorized kerosene. Mix according to
the following table to obtain the desired
concentration of 0.25% or 0.5% strength.
Use higher concentration (0.5%) to control
reduce heavy cockroach infestations. Use
the lower concentration (0.25%) on light
infestations.
